- October 26, 2024
 - \$100 Silent Auction Basket & \$25 Class Auction Basket
- *If requirement not fulfilled: \$125 charged to TADS

Fit for Life

- May 3, 2025
 - \$100 Pledges
- *If requirement not fulfilled: \$100 charged to TADS

Write-A-Thon

- April 3, 2025
 - Each student provides 3 names & addresses prior to (in school) event.
- *If requirement not fulfilled: \$300 charge to TADS if names are not turned in by due date

Parents are needed to fulfill **3** volunteer roles from the below events

Families have satisfied their volunteer requirements when a parent participates in roles from any of the fundraisers or listed school events.

***At least one Role must be fulfilled with the Harvest Banquet**

Fundraising & Family Volunteering = Reduced Tuition

Scenarios to demonstrate when requirements have been met:

1. A parent volunteers in a role at three events
2. A parent volunteers for 2 roles at any one event, and 1 role at another event
3. A husband and wife both volunteer for separate roles at one event, plus a parent fills one role at another event

- Parents will incur a \$500 charge to TADS for unmet volunteer requirements
- A parent who chairs or co-chairs an event satisfies their volunteering by this one role
- As long as you have filled 3 volunteer roles at the above events either by one parent or split between both parents, the requirements have been satisfied
